

Adoration's History 1982

1982 began with a cross-country ski day for families in January held in Eagle, WI. In February a Pot Luck Supper was held featuring Dan Puotinen of Pine Lake Camp presented a film, "A Place of Grace." Also in February a Ski week-end was offered in Upper Michigan. Bible Studies continued this year. In January the Youth Group went tobagonning. We again participated in Lutheran World Relief, collected toys that were delivered to Redeemer Lutheran Church, and collected \$1,000 worth of food that went to the Central City Task Force. Sunday Church School had an enrollment of 60 students and Vacation Church School was held August 16-20. A Seniors' Group was formed in conjunction with St. Stephen the Martry Lutheran Church and in April they enjoyed an outing to the Domes with a lunch following. Worship Services during Lent were held on Wednesdays at 7:30 PM, Maundy Thursday and Good Friday Services at 7:30 PM, and Easter Services at 6:30 (Sunrise Breakfast Service), 9:00 & 10:30 AM. Services were again held on Thanksgiving Eve as well as Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. Ending membership totals were 592 baptized and 426 confirmed members. Average weekly attendance was 179.
