

Sunday, March 14th is another Curbside Communion from 9AM-10AM. We hope that many of you will be able to be present. You know that, in the event of blizzard or freezing rain we will not hold Curbside Communion. If it is, we will cancel and reschedule the next event. Ted, Jim and Barb will make the decision by 7 a.m. You can call Ted Lazaris, Jim Haas, or Barb Regent if you want any clarity. If the weather is good, COME!

- Your offering.
- Books for the book sale, if you have any.
- **Special offering – Feminine Hygiene Products or Underwear** – items include sanitary napkins or pads, tampons, underpants, etc.

Repeat Guidelines for Receiving Holy Communion:

- Please come in a vehicle.
- Make sure you are all wearing a mask. We will provide you with them if you forget.
- You will enter the parking lot from the west. An attendant will be there to welcome you and help guide you. They will also take your name for contact tracing purposes.
- It is possible that a line may form on Edgerton Avenue in either direction. Please follow the vehicle in front of you and be mindful of our neighbors' driveways.
- Please wear a mask when you are in front of the Assisting Minister, Barbara Regent. Again, if you don't have a mask, an attendant will be available in the parking lot with disposable masks.
- When you are the vehicle "on deck" to receive Holy Communion from the Assisting Minister, please stay one vehicle length back for safety and privacy purposes. You will be coming to her with the driver's side near the church, the car facing east. PUT YOUR CAR IN PARK.
- The church will be closed and you will not be able to go into the church while you are coming to receive Holy Communion.
- When you reach the Assisting Minister near the walkway that enters into the church, she will give you Holy Communion that will already have been consecrated in a prepackaged set, which includes a wafer and grape juice, and give it to you through the driver's window along with a sheet of prayers to use when consuming it at home. A blessing will then be provided. The Assisting Minister will be wearing a mask, as will you, to protect both of you. There will be no physical contact.
- After you have received the elements of Holy Communion, you can move forward to drop off any other items you have brought. Afterwards, please immediately exit the parking lot using the east entrance so that you do not cause a back-up or congestion in the parking lot.
- Again, after you receive Communion, please proceed out of the east exit/entrance to the parking lot so that others can now come into the lot. Please call if you have any questions!
