Guidelines for this WORSHIP SERVICE:

- Please come in a vehicle.
- Make sure you are all **wearing a mask at all times**. We will provide you with them if you forget.
- You will **enter the parking lot at the West Entrance. An attendant** will be there to welcome you and help guide you. They will **also take your name for contact tracing purposes, hand you a bulletin and collect any offering you may have.**
- It is possible that a line may form on Edgerton Avenue in either direction. Please follow the vehicle in front of you and be mindful of our neighbors' driveways.
- **Car parkers** will aid you in finding a parking spot facing the front doors of the church.
- **There will be no roaming the parking lot or mingling with other family units, in order to help maintain social distancing.**
- **The Worship Service will begin at 9 AM with Pastor Matt Schlake-Kruse presiding. Please stay in your cars, keep your masks on, and roll down the windows to hear the service. Follow the order of worship in your bulletin and any other special instructions given by Pastor Matt.**
- Distribution of Holy Communion:
 - a. Please wear a mask when Pastor Matt or one of the Communion Assistants comes to your driver's side door to distribute the pre-packaged Holy Communion to you and your passengers. All units will be given to the driver. The Pastor and his helpers will all be wearing a mask, as will you, to protect both of you. There will be no physical contact.
 - b. The church will be closed and you will not be able to go into the church while you are coming to this worship service.
 - c. After all cars have received Holy Communion, a blessing will then be provided to the whole congregation.
- The worship service will then conclude with blessings and a hymn.
- The **car parkers will then aid the dismissal of cars** from the parking lot in an orderly fashion.
- Please carefully Depart in Peace and exit the parking lot using the appointed exits so that you do not cause a back-up or congestion in the parking lot.
