The Meru Hunger Relief Task Force received information and photos from the Bishop's Office last week and discovered:

*Approximately 60% of the Diocese of Meru has serious drought conditions as seen in this recent photo.

***About 8,000 Families are in URGENT NEED.**

*Almost all people in the Eastern District and the southern part of the Diocese are severely affected by three consecutive years of drought. (Many have no synod partner congregation.)

The Greater Milwaukee Synod is collecting funds to go to a "Common Basket" for the Diocese of Meru to distribute to all who are in the greatest need.

Since 2001, Adoration formally joined and has extended welcome to all through participation as an RIC (Reconciling in Christ) congregation. In part, this means that our congregation welcomes all persons--without regard to race, ethnicity, social status, gender, sexual orientation or ability to full membership and participation in the ministry and life of the church.

Since 1983, the Reconciling in Christ (RIC) Program has been a public way for faith communities to see, name, celebrate, and advocate for people of all sexual orientations, gender identities, and gender expressions in the Lutheran church. The RIC Program is made up of congregations, synods, colleges, seminaries, outdoor ministries, and other Lutheran organizations. The purpose of the RIC Program is to ensure the welcome, inclusion, celebration, and advocacy for people of all sexual orientations, gender identities, and gender expressions; work for racial equity and commit to anti-racist work and support this both locally and on a national level.


Needed: Communion Assistants
