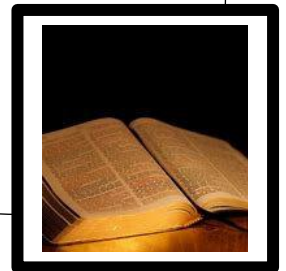

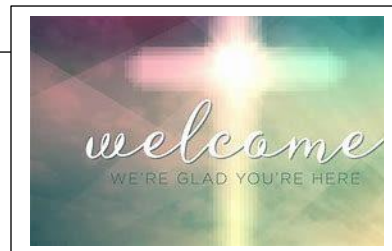
New Member Information Session: September 25th After Worship

Could you teach or help for 3-4 weeks of Sunday School?

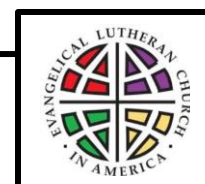

On Labor Day Weekend, we lift-up ***"Sufficient, Sustainable Livelihood for All"*** the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America's social statement on economic life. The statement expresses ELCA teaching that economic activity is a means through which God's will is served for the thriving and well-being of humankind and the care of the earth. It recognizes that even though sin distorts human activity, we are called to practice economic activity justly and with special concern for those who live in poverty. Toward that purpose, it discusses commerce, law, vocation, public policy, work, human dignity, agriculture, business, and efforts to empower those who live in poverty.
