- Need 160 Notebooks: 70-80 sheets, Wide or College-Ruled, 8"x10"
- Need 40 Rulers with centimeters and inches (30 centimeters & 12")
- Need 40 Pencil sharpeners
- Need 40 Blunt scissors
- Need 200 Unsharpened #2 pencils with erasers
- Need 200 Black or blue ballpoint pens – no gel
- Need 40 14 or 24 count boxed crayons
- Need 40 2-1/2" erasers
