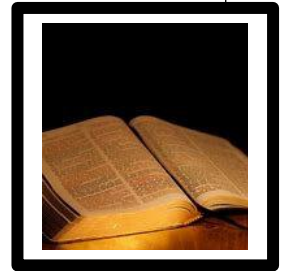

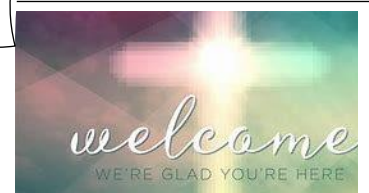
New Member Information Session: September 25th After Worship
