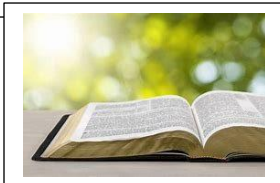
Sunday Morning Adult Education Resumes Soon!

We'll read and discuss the book: *Reconciling Scripture for Lutherans* by theologians Austen Hartke and Emmy Kegler.

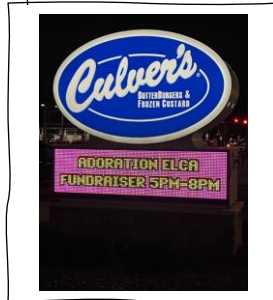
If you'd like a copy of the book, sign up in the gathering space. They are \$10 each.

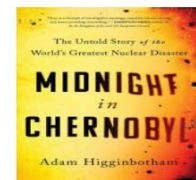

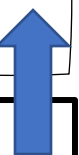
