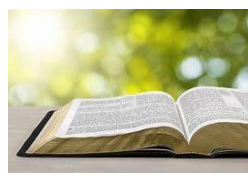
Sunday Morning Adult Education Resumes Soon!

As we enter a new year, join Pastor Matt as we explore the biblical roots of our Lutheran faith and how they can help us live into our identity as an RIC Congregation!

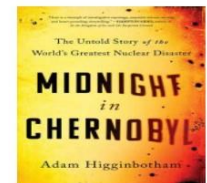
We'll read and discuss the book: Reconciling Scripture for Lutherans by theologians Austen Hartke and Emmy Kegler.
