The last Culver's Night, January 16th, netted the church **\$393.02!** Thank you to everyone who volunteered and/or those who bought some dinner and dessert!

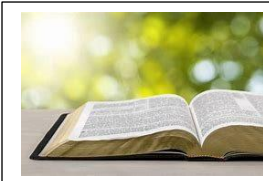

Join us after worship on Sunday, February 19th.

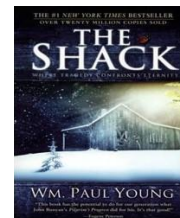

Water and Spirit provides daily devotions for each day from Ash Wednesday to Holy

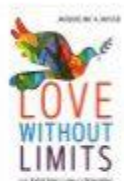
Saturday using texts from the gospel of John.
