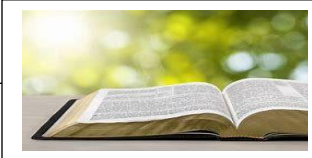




Worship with us as we begin the season of Lent.

Water and Spirit provides daily devotions for each day from Ash Wednesday to Holy

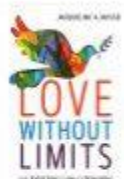
Saturday using texts from the gospel of John.
