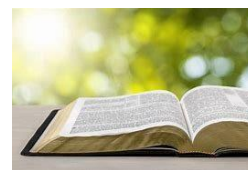
REMINDER

Join us after worship on Sundays January 29th, February 5th and 19th.



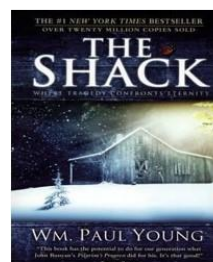
