**Love without Limits, Pray without Ceasing**

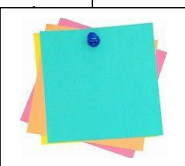
*Making the Prayers of the People "Of the People"*

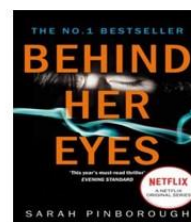
