The Annual Mission Meeting of Adoration Lutheran Church will be held on Sunday, May 21st following the conclusion of worship.

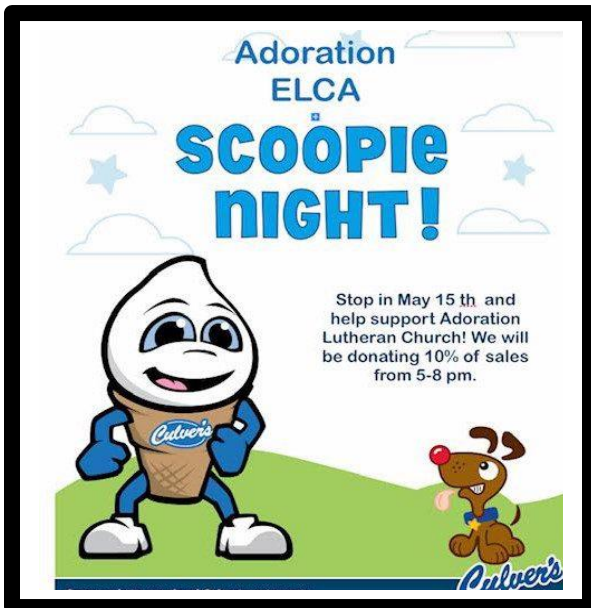
Church Council Elections will be held at this meeting.
